Dear members,

In this very year, the Association had our 25th Anniversary and witnessed a jubilant beginning of the 2nd millennium. Thus, it is a good time to take advantage of this opportunity to promote the lawn bowling sport. It has been a difficult start for each and every committee member, and it is only after great effort that we could now share the joy of accomplishment. At the end of the day, we feel relieved to see that the Association has been able to function more effectively.

At the AGM on 29.3.1999, soon after the new committee office bearers were elected, the outgoing committee had stepped out from the meeting angrily, even before all the agenda items have been discussed, leaving the meeting in a chaotic state. Most of the five incoming Executive Officers were new hands then, but fortunately, our experienced Vice President Mrs. Amy Liu rendered her ready help and the meeting was able to continue in order.

During our term of office, under the close co-operation of all the Executive Officers and the assistance of the Committee members, and the support of the members, we were able to achieve quite an outstanding result. Our membership enrolment now is close to three hundred and eighty. In 1999, we scored a bronze medal in the 8th Asia Pacific Bowls Championships, and in the Singles event, we were the 3rd runner-up. As a result of such creditable performance, we were awarded a prize of \$13,600 by the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China.

It had been difficult at the beginning of the term of office. The functioning of the Association nearly came to a halt, as there was no annual statement of accounts for the previous year 98-99, and there was no record of income and expenditure except for the first three months. In this regard, I express my special thanks to our Treasurer, Ms. Suen Fei Fei, who managed to dig out the old records and put the accounts in order. So that every member could now receive today, the updated and audited statement of accounts of our Association. In addition, my thanks go to Hui Sik Wing & Co. for the auditing which took more than half a year to finish.

There have been three EGMs in order to clarify the misunderstanding amongst members of the "Points System" for the selection of HK-China Team. In the same year, we celebrated the 25th Anniversary of the Association and the event turned out to be a success. Our special thanks go to the generous support of the 25th Anniversary Organizing Committee including Ms. Lena Yeung, Ms. Candy Cheng, Mrs. Cecilia Smith, Ms. Helen Lai and Ms. Stella Lee. Twice, the HK-China team participated in International Events. I would like to extend our thanks to the Manageress, Ms. Julie Chan, for organizing the team with such efficiency. Our thanks also go to CCC, which held the CCC Millennium Bowls Tournament, moreover, it has voluntarily made its lawns available for the training of the Inter-School instructors.

I myself, as the President for the first time, take great pleasure to thank you all for the opportunity and support. With no doubt my personal growth has been greatly enhanced. Furthermore, I had to take up the dual role as President and Vice President, when I came back from Malaysia only to learn that my Vice President has tendered her resignation. In this light, I have to thank the volunteers, Ms. Jennifer Luk, Ms. Eva Hui, and Ms. Stephanie Chung, Ms. Stella Lee and our Sports Executive Ms. Amy Mok, for their support and share of the heavy workload.

In addition, we appointed the Hon. Secretary, Ms. Sheila Shee, as HKLLBA delegate to attend the Ordinary General Meeting of the IWBB held in Australia on 6th March 2000, to discuss the possible unification of the World Bowls, and she was able to relay relevant information during discussion, and the decision adopted at the meeting.

As the Chinese saying goes "In order to have a better view, you have to go up a floor higher". This very millennium is a very unusual period, and the unification of the World Bowls is a trend in this new era. May I wish that both Associations of the Ladies and the Gents could be unified in one dynamic "Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association". In the year 2003, when Hong Kong hosts the 10th Asia Pacific Bowls Championships, the event will certainly come off with flying color.

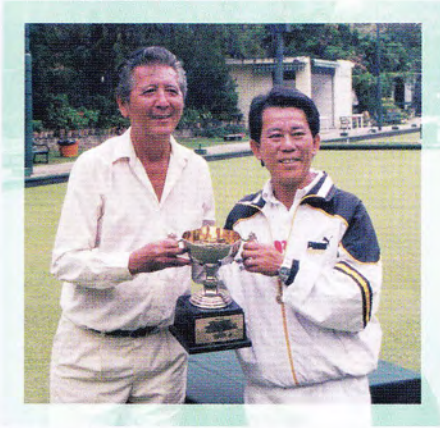

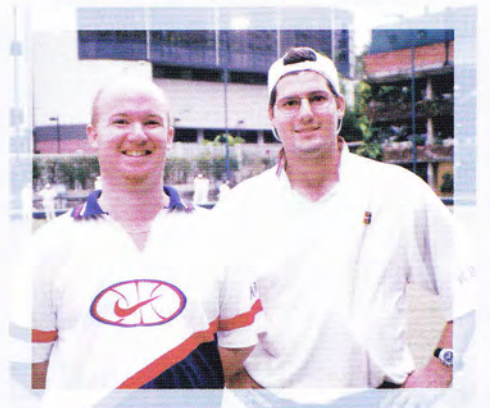

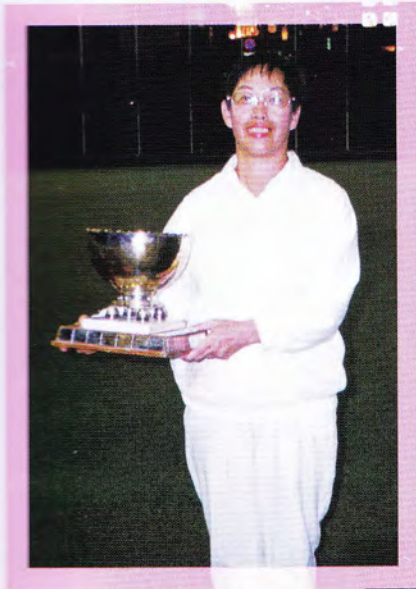

The 16th Classic was held from 30 October through to 7 November at Kowloon Bowling Green Club. The weather was kind with a cooling breeze present for much of the time. The greens looked attractive with a good coverage of grass albeit they played slow but relatively true.

## SINGLES

The singles event started in September with a qualification competition for the 33 local places in the draw, other local places were given to National Singles Winners and HK Internationals. There were 88 entries this year, slightly lower than in previous years.

Last years finalists Adam Jeffery and Willie Lai were seeded one and two respectively. Adam continued as in previous years with a quiet consistent style of play beating Stuart Airey of England in round 3, 26-18. Stuart had a narrow escape in the previous round against Raymond Wu, who let Stuart escape after holding the lead for much of the game. Chi Chi Fernandes beat Graham Garnett of Zimbabwe and David Harding of Wales before losing very narrowly to Ibraheim Jusoh of Malaysia who proved to be a very focussed bowler. He just was not good enough to beat Adam Jeffery, although the 25-12 scoreline belies the quality of Ibraheim's play.



In the lower quarter of the top half Alex Marshall, the current World Indoor Singles Champion had tight wins over David Tso (HKLBA), James Covell (Canada) and Kerry Chapman (New Zealand). Kerry and Russell Meyer overcame the slow greens, often the Kiwi downfall, very well, both reached the quarterfinal. Adam Jeffery produced an outstanding game to beat Alex Marshall in the semi-final. Alex's comment after the game was that he believed he had played one of the best games of his life and still lost 25-12 to the Australian. One end epitomized Alex's difficulty, he burnt the end three times and in each replayed end Adam surrounded the jack with bowls.

Noel Graham of Ireland, a former winner, lost to Russell Meyer of NZ in round 3 and Russell met Steve Glasson playing with his yellow bowls in the quarterfinal. The Australian won quite comfortably with his bowls, which appeared to be size seven, but were only size four. Willie Lai last year's finalist lost in Round 2 to Andrew Wills of England. Alistair White, a very quiet Scotsman, beat Andrew to go through to the Quarter Final. Noel Kennedy had a very tough game against Bill McMahon with Bill lying game before Noel pushed his bowl out. Noel then beat one of the South African second row forwards 'Daren Smit' before disposing of Alistair White. Noel then qualified for his third final and prevented it from becoming an all-Australian affair by beating Steve in the semifinal.

The final proved a disappointment especially for Noel who did not really get into the competition with Adam able to control the game after the first few ends. Adam won 25-16 to take the Hong Kong Classic Singles title to become the first person to take the title for the third successive year. Paul Richards (Australia) and Graham Robertson (Scotland) have previously won the Classic Singles in successive years.

## PAIRS

Monday as usual was the start of the Pairs competition, described as one of the most prestigious but demanding Pairs Competitions in the World.



Day one is often the opportunity to catch the Internationals cold and score a few upsets. KBGC beat Canada, and KCC drew against Ireland. As the week progressed, these proved not to be not upsets just that the Club sides were as good as the Internationals. On the Tuesday morning KCC met England the reigning champions who led 13-2 and 17-4, but Mike Dowie, the KCC lead, came on to a good game, and Jacky Wong at skip played some adventurous shots that came off, and then KCC were in the lead. The 'cricketers' were three shots up with two ends to play, and were holding three shots when Airey ditched the jack with his last bowl to keep the match alive. But, although Wills, built up a good position on the last end, Airey could not repeat the trick, and KCC claimed a single to win by two shots, 23-21.

Scotland, who had won their first three games by impressive margins, also bit the dust in the fourth session, going down to KBGC Pair, Harry Thornton and Anthony Carstairs, 23-15. HKLBA pair, Nelson To and David Tso beat Australia. An allegedly scratch pairing from Wales - David Harding and Andrew Fleming, finished the second day as the only pair with a 100% record. after Wales had edged home, 21-20, against Daron Smith and Bobby Donnelly of South Africa.

Thursday was scheduled for three games and in the morning Australia's Adam Jeffery and Steve Glasson tasted defeat against Scotland, and the Malaysian pair lost to a very ordinary pair from Zimbabwe. Brunei, who had been invited for the first time to increase Asian participation, recorded their first win against HKPBC.



With four sessions to play, two local teams - CCC and KBGC seemed to be in with a great chance of qualifying for the quarter finals. The hopes of the HK pair of Adam Poynton and James Cheng took a Thursday evening knock when they were overwhelmed by Malaysia's Ibrahim Jusoh and Tazman Tahir.

By Friday morning England, who were still hoping to create a record by winning the title for the third year running, appeared unlikely to qualify but then beat New Zealand, Malaysia and Ireland in quick succession.

The final round robin session is always an exciting affair, with several pairs jostling for places in the knockout stage - even if others have already clinched theirs. This year, for example, KCC and Ireland were already assured of quarterfinal spots in Group 1, while Scotland, Wales and KBGC were definitely through in Group 2. It had been clear from day one that Scotland had no intention of repeating previous years escapades of late night socializing making qualification difficult.

England and HK had to win their matches against IRC and CCC to be sure of qualifying in Group 1, while New Zealand, Malaysia and CCC were hoping they would slip up, so that they could sneak in. Even if CCC beat HK they still needed Malaysia to lose for CCC to qualify.

Andy Wills and Stuart Airey found themselves in trouble and were only one shot in front of plucky IRC pair J S Dhillon and A K Razack with only two ends left to play - but managed to score a five to put them in the clear. HK left it even later against Fung Kee Tong and Willie Lai, from the CCC. In a tense finish, the scores were level, 18-18, when the last end got underway, but a 'Magnificent Seven' gave HK a flattering 25-18 victory.

New Zealand's Kerry Chapman and Russell Meyer lost to league leaders Mike Dowie and Jacky Wong of KCC, but Malaysia's challenge was real enough - they beat HKCC's Grandy Lui and Andrew Robertson, and finished in fifth place, just out of the frame.

With only one place up for grabs in Group 2, South Africa's Daron Smit and Bobby Donnelly were hoping that Adam Jeffery and Steve Glasson's Aussie challenge would come off the rails - but the Aussies beat Canada's Mark Sandford and James Covell, 23-16, so that the Springboks' 34-17 win over HK Police was to no avail.

The quarter finals proved to be the end of the line for the defending champions, Andy Wills, from Gloucestershire, and Cumbria's Stuart Airey, they were stopped in their tracks by a Welsh pairing, David Harding and Andrew Fleming. The Welsh duo, both still in their twenties stormed to a shock 29-10 victory, scoring shots at will, and including a five, two fours and two trebles in their impressive haul.

Scotland's Alastair White and Alex Marshall led HK 8-3, after four ends, but were kept on eight shots for ten ends mid-game, as the HK duo charged ahead, 18-8. James Cheng, who defeated world outdoor singles champion, Tony Allcock, twice in one-day in Zimbabwe in September, has now added the scalp of world indoor singles champion, Marshall.

Ireland's Jonathon Ross and Noel Graham scored two fives on their way into a 17-9 lead over the hotly-tipped Aussies, but were caught, 20-20 by the 21st end. Glasson killed the 21st end once, then played a perfect bowl to take the shot that levelled the scores, but he could not turn an adverse head his way on the extra end, and the Irish pair got home, 21-20.

In an exciting local derby, KCC met KBGC for a place in the semi finals. Jacky Wong, who had been playing brilliantly all week, maintained his impressive form, and the 'cricketers' were 7-0 up after only two ends, but a five from KBGC narrowed the gap to 13-11 after eight. KCC were not to be denied, however, and they powered to a 26-17 victory in front of a lively crowd from the neighbor clubs.

In the semi-final Ireland beat HK, James Cheng impressed everyone with his ability to get out of tight corners. At one stage, Ireland looked poised to run away with it, but HK pegged them back from 15-7 to 15-11 before Ross brought the mat up the green, and Ireland went away again to win, 21-12.

Wales, who had defeated the defending champions, England, 29-10, again went on the rampage, this time beating KCC, 36-15. Jacky Wong lost patience, started to fire, and unfortunately took some of his own bowls out, giving Wales some big counts

In the Ireland v Wales final the luck went against Wales. On the 10th end, when the score was 10-3 to Ireland, Fleming took an Irish bowl out for a count of six, but Graham drew the shot with the last bowl of the end. Then, on the very next end, Fleming ditched the jack for three shots, only to see the jack bounce back on to the green, to lie shot down. On the 12th, Wales were holding shot, Fleming tried to make it five, but gave the shot away. Fleming took an Irish bowl out for seven on the 13th end, and although Graham cut the count to five, it brought Wales back into contention. But Wales promptly dropped a four on the 14th, when Fleming was again unlucky. Ireland were holding shot, Fleming was trying to get another bowl in the head, when he turned out the only Welsh bowl in the head. From there Ireland quietly played on to take the Classic Pairs 24-11.

For Graham, it brought back memories of 1995, when he won the Classic singles title, but it was Ross's first visit to Hong Kong. The Welsh Pair certainly strengthened their position for further invitations, two or three years ago they were at substantial risk.



The Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association was delighted to accept the invitation from the Zimbabwe Lawn Bowls Association to the Masters Singles tournament and Six-Nation Test Series held in Bulawayo, Zimbabwe from August 27th to 5th September 1999.

The six Nations participating were: Zimbabwe, South Africa, England, Jersey, Australia and Hong Kong China.

The most striking aspect of this tournament was the extremely high standard of the opposing nations teams. Many were represented by their prospective World Bowls Teams with the exception of Australia who were represented by their Under-25 team.

The Hong Kong China Team consisted of Jacky Wong, James Cheng, Nelson To, Harry Thornton and Oscar Adem.

## MASTER SINGLES

Prior to the Test Series all players participated in the 3-Day Masters Singles Tournament. They were divided into 4 sections of 8 players. Each section played best of 3 sets round robin with the resulting top 2 players from each section going forward to the knock-out phase on the Sunday.

None of our players made it to the knock-out phase but Nelson To and James Cheng both finished 3rd in their sections; a very creditable performance in this high-quality field. The Masters Title was won by Tony Allcock of England.

## TEST SERIES

This was conducted on a round-robin basis over 5 days of play. Each morning Pairs and Triples were played and in the afternoon, Rinks and Singles.

## OVERALL COMMENTS ON PERFORMANCE

That bad start however resulted in large negative shots differences which cost the team in the final placing.

## PAIRS

The Pairs were well beaten by South Africa then bounced back to beat Jersey. They lost narrowly to England after leading for 19 ends. Won 1, lost 4, finished 5th.



### **TRIPLES**

After their initial heavy defeat by South Africa the Triples were much more competitive, only losing over the closing ends against Jersey and Zimbabwe. Too many shots were given away at the end in one of those games. They won their last two matches well against England and Australia. Won 2, lost 3, finishing 5th. (although 3rd, 4th & 5th were only separated by shots difference).

### **FOURS**

We were the most competitive in this discipline. After losing heavily to South Africa on the first day the rink recorded good wins against Jersey then Zimbabwe before losing very close games on the last end against England and Australia. Won 2, lost 3, finishing 4th.

The 8th Asia Pacific Bowls Championships was staged over a period of 11 days from 21-30 September in Kuala Lumpur. Along with the host country, Australia, Brunei, Canada, Cook Island, Fiji, Japan, New Zealand, Norfolk Island, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Singapore, Thailand, United States of America and Hong Kong China were participating in the Championships.

The Hong Kong China Men's team was represented by Adam Poynton in Singles, Willie Lai and Jacky Wong in the Pairs, Adam Poynton, David Tso and James Cheng in the Triples. The Fours were Willie, David, James and Jacky.

The team departed on 17 September together with the Ladies Team. Practice was arranged at the tournament venue at Bukit Kiara Lawn Bowls Complex where the lawn bowls competition of the 1998 Commonwealth Games was hosted.

The 15 participating countries were divided into two sections for each discipline. Winners of each section competed for Gold and Silver with the runners-up being joint Bronze medal winners.

There was an impressive Opening Ceremony on 21 September officiated by the President and Chairman of the Organizing Committee. The 15 countries with their players paraded on the green. Speeches were delivered by some of the distinguished guests including the Executives from the World Bowls Board and the International Women's Bowling Board.

## PAIRS

The Pair of Willie Lai and Jacky Wong got off a very good start in the opening game defeating Japan 53-2 (the highest score of the tournament). They went on to beat Brunei 28-12, Samoa 37-17 and Singapore 21-19. Match 5 was a tough game against PNG who played brilliant bowls from start to finish to edge HK by 21-19.

The game against Fiji was a great battle with HK down 2-12 after 11 ends, came back strongly to level at 19-19 after 19 ends but lost two shots on following end. Playing the last end HK held 3 shots, but the Fiji Skipper, Caucau, with his last bowl wicked the front bowl and sat on our third shot to allow HK to take 2 shots to tie 21-21. HK finished 4th in the section and ranked 7 in overall position.

## TRIPLES

Adam, David and James in the Triples played very well throughout the event. They beat Brunei 24-13 comfortably in the opening game. HK continued by edging Japan 24-9, USA 19-16, Canada 29-14 and Norfolk Island 37-11. After 6 games, HK led the section with 11 points followed by Fiji 10 and Canada 8. The last game with Fiji was a crucial one. HK trailed 1-10 after 8 ends and came back magnificently to 17-17 in 16 ends before losing 17-23 and winning a bronze medal.



## SINGLES

Adam Poynton started his first campaign against Canada and lost 5-21 to the eventual Gold medalist. Adam's first victory was in his third game against Samoa where he won 21-10. In match 4, Adam lost to a patient draw bowler from Singapore 12-21. He had a good and exciting game with NZ in following round. At one time the score was 18-18 and Adam was holding 3 shots. Andrew Curtain of NZ drove with his last bowl and took Adam's 3 shots out to lay 1 shot 19-18. Adam managed to get one shot back on the next end before losing 19-21. He beat Malaysia 21-8 in the final match for his second victory. Adam played very well to finish 6th in the section and ranked 10th overall in the Singles competition.

## FOURS

The Fours started off strongly in the first match against Malaysia but lost 18-19. The Quartet recovered from the defeat to beat Samoa 25-15, Japan 24-14, Brunei 22-16 and Canada 30-15. After 5 games, HK and Malaysia were joint first with 8 points, PNG, Brunei and Canada were on 6 points. HK had 2 remaining games with NZ and PNG, they beat New Zealand in the morning then beat PNG 28-11 to ensure a Bronze medal.



Australia beat Malaysia for a Gold. HK and Fiji were the joint Bronze medalists. HK finished second place of the section and ranked third of the overall position of the Fours competition.

At the end of the Championships competition, Australia was in first overall position of the Men's events with 115 points, Fiji was seconded with 102 points and Hong Kong was ranked third with 76 points. HK maintained the same ranking position as in the 7th Asia Pacific Championships in Australia.

The 8th Asia Pacific Bowls Championships 1999 was held from 21-30 September in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The tournament matches took place at Bukit Kiara Lawn Bowls Complex, about half an hour's drive from Hotel Grand Olympic where all the players were accommodated. There were 14 countries taking part namely Australia, Brunei, Canada, Cook Island, Fiji, Japan, Malaysia, New Zealand, Norfolk Island, Papua New Guinea, Singapore, Thailand, United States of America and Hong Kong China.

The Hong Kong China Women's team included Angela Chau playing in the Singles, Fanny Fernandes paired with Danna Chiu, Julia Wong skipped the Triples with Angela Chau and Linda Da Luz and the Fours with Danna Chiu, Fanny Fernandes and Linda Da Luz. All the games were played at the Bukit Kiara Lawn Bowls Complex which was specially built for the 1998 Commonwealth Games.

The competition commenced with the Pairs and Triples, immediately after the opening ceremony. The 14 countries were divided into 2 sections of 7, each country had to play 6 round-robin matches for every event. The winner of the section would play for Gold and Silver medals while both runners-up would receive Bronze.

## PLAYERS' PERFORMANCE

### TRIPLES
