A total of 737 bowlers played in the Summer League out of which 251 played as skip on at least one occasion. This is a slight decrease in the number of players and skips participating last year (14 and 28 respectively). The Champion Rink competition again proved to be keenly contested with the second division being decided on the very last match.

I would like to thank Kedington Wines, the new sponsor of the Summer League, for continuing to provide bottles of whisky to those sides lucky enough to score 7 or 8 shots on an end; the printing of the score cards and \$8,000 in prize money for the first division. As agreed by the General Committee, this will be divided in the proportion 65%/35%, ie. \$5,200 to the winners and \$2,800 to the runners-up. With regard to the whisky, a total of 36 bottles were consumed. Thirty one of these being awarded for a seven and five for an eight.

My thanks also go to members of the National League Panel, Bob Brown, Wyndson Ho, M.B.Hassan and Brian Poynton, for their support and advice during the leagues. Fortunately, disputed matters were few and far between and I attribute this to a better understanding of the recently revised National By-Laws. I would like to give special thanks to Brian Poynton who received, collated, advised the press and printed each weeks results in a most efficient manner.

In conclusion, I would like to thank all Conveners and Team Captains for telephoning the results in each Saturday to the HKLBA answering machine and for sending in completed score cards to Brian at an early date. For many years I have been critical of Clubs who have not been helpful in this respect, but this year has seen a big improvement. This has meant that for most weeks, results and league tables were printed in the Sunday papers. My thanks to everyone.






