在 2006-2007 季度，我們樂於看到參與草地滾球運動的人數正持續上升。在超級聯賽中，有四隊新的男子隊加入，而三人聯賽則新增了七隊男子及九隊女子隊。雖然場地的不足為我們增添了一些問題，但在聯賽副會長及其小組的努力下，我們終可在各方滿意的情況下完成賽事。

公開賽在新任副會長 Cliff Imeson 接管後，帶來了幾項備受歡迎的新意，特別是集中了幾項總決賽在輕鬆愉快氣氛下進行的總決賽嘉年華，我們在預見的將來相信都會採用這型式進行決賽。我在此祝賀九龍木球會在 2006-2007 的驕人成績，他們共贏得男子單人賽冠軍、男子雙人賽冠軍、男子三人賽冠軍、女子雙人賽冠軍、女子單人淘汰賽冠軍及男子四人賽亞軍等，特別的是九龍木球會的趙仲聰及楊吉健共同獲得全年最佳男子球員獎項，在香港草地滾球歷史寫下光輝一頁。

- e) 世界冠中之冠錦標賽(新西蘭基督城，2006 年 11 月)
石惠燕代表香港在 23 參賽國中名列 12
- f) 亞太草地滾球錦標賽(新西蘭基督城，2007 年 1 月)
銀牌：男子雙人賽 – 黎維斌及何觀球
銅牌：男子四人賽 – 黎維斌、姜龍威、鄭仲明及何觀球
女子四人賽 – 蔣玲芝、尹杏儀、姚采伸及李麥伊嫻
香港的成績亦因而可以成功晉身 2008 世界錦標賽。

我衷心的祝賀上述各位得勝球員。

持續發展及培訓青少年是我們首要的項目。除一貫常規訓練青年軍外，青苗計劃在 2006 年 4 月份已在兩個場地進行訓練。此計劃在 2007-2008 會繼續舉辦，並相信會擴展至第三個訓練場地。在此感謝發展副會長、統籌員陳偉生及青年軍的教練們。

Message from The President

In the 2006-2007 season, we saw a continuous and steady increase of players taking up lawn bowls. Four new men's teams joined the premier league, and for the triples league, seven new men's teams and nine new ladies teams came aboard. Although the number of rinks available for league games still causes us a few problems, VP League and his panel did do a very good job in organizing and arranging these games which concluded in a satisfactory manner.

With Cliff Imeson taking over as VP National Championships, a number of new changes and new ideas were introduced and were well received by all, in particular the Finals Carnival which received nothing but favourable comments. We can expect this carnival to become more and more spectacular in our future years. While still on this subject, I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate KCC for their excellent achievements in the 2006-2007 National Premier Championships competitions, namely : - winners of men's singles, men's pairs, men's triples, ladies pairs, ladies knock-out singles, runner-up of men's national fours and two members of KCC, Jimmy Chiu and K.K. Yeung shared the title of the Bowler of the Year award. This is a record in the HKLBA history and is worthy to be recorded.

Internationally, we continue to take part in most of the major international events and achieved the following results :-

- a) Singapore International Lawn Bowls Championships (June 2006, Singapore)
Cherry Yung, Alan Lai, James Ho and Rita Shek of YDT were sent to this tournament and finished 5th overall in the men's and ladies pairs competition.
- b) Asian Lawn Bowls Championship (August 2006, Brunei)

Silver medals : Robin Chok and Peggy Ma, Men & Ladies Singles
- c) Asian under 25 Singles Championship (August 2006, Brunei)
Silver medal : Ken Chan
- d) Michael Aston-Philips Challenge Cup (September 2006, California, USA)
Silver medal : Ken Chan, Men's Singles
- e) World Singles Champion of Champions (November 2006, Christchurch, New Zealand)
Rita Shek represented Hong Kong and finished 12 out of 23 countries.
- f) Asia Pacific Championship (January 2007, Christchurch, New Zealand)
Silver medal : Pat Lai & Danny Ho, Men's Pairs
Bronze medal : Pat Lai, James Keung, James Cheng & Danny HO, Men's Fours
Grace Chu, Wanis Sze, Camilla Leung & Elizabeth Li, Ladies Fours

The overall result also qualified Hong Kong to the 2008 World Championship.

My sincere congratulations to all those mentioned above.

The development of our youth continues to be our prime target in the season. Apart from the normal YDT training, the Young Athletes Training Scheme was launched in April 2006 using two centres. After two phases of training, a total of 46 youngsters took part and finished the course with some excellent results. This scheme will continue in the 2007-2008 season and is expected to expand to three centres. A job well done by VP Development, Eric Chan and the team of youth team coaches.

With the introduction of a new web-site, the office administration is now running smoothly and can cope with the ever increasing demand in the development of the sport. My sincere gratitude to all the Officers, Council members and office staff for their service and contribution, to LCSD and all other sponsors for their generous and continuous support to our Association.

在國際賽方面，我們派隊參加了第二屆新加坡國際草地滾球錦標賽、第五屆亞洲草地滾球錦標賽、第三屆亞洲25歲以下單人賽草地滾球錦標賽、首屆中國盃錦標邀請賽、Michael Ashton-Philips 國際盃邀請賽、冠中之冠世界賽、第十二屆亞太草地滾球錦標賽、第一屆獅城青少年草地滾球錦標賽及世界青少年盃單人賽(室內)。在本地舉行的國際活動則有香港國際草地滾球精英賽、老虎盃、香港足球會四人混合賽等。總會在派出隊伍參加各賽事時也需要作出很多安排工作，趁此機會我希望向曾經協助籌備的義務工作人員致謝。同時向曾在本地賽事中義務當值的裁判、記分員致謝。務請各位記著，總會歡迎你及任何會員於任何事務及任何時間的義務幫忙。

The official 2006/2007 year began in May 2006 with our AGM and the uncontested re-election of 7 officers and the election of new officer Cliff Imeson as Vice President (National Championships). With our 31 associate member clubs, our year then proceeded at its usual frenetic pace of league and national competitions, and training courses for bowlers, coaches, umpires and the new training scheme for young athletes. In particular, a National Championships Finals day was successfully introduced and held, at which a number of the premier competition finals were held at the same time on the 1 day instead of each immediately following its semi-final thus creating an event for our members participation. The other notable change was the successful introduction and implementation of our on-line league results reporting and verification system enabling each Club to enter their results quickly and efficiently.

Members will have noted our ever-expanding web-site with more information which we will continue to endeavour to include what our members want and maintaining it as up-to-date as possible.

Behind the scenes in the office, Leona and Keyo continued to work hard to keep up with the office's heavy workload on the routine tasks and the ever changing situations on the league and national competitions, training courses, coaching and umpire classes and the international tournaments. Fortunately, our very experienced former administrative assistant, Man, was employed on a part-time basis to help us keep up-to-date with everything. It is always very important that we elected officers contribute to the organization and management tasks as much as possible and not leave everything to our sparse staffing resources, and that we serve you, our members, the best we can and ensure that our Association's activities run smoothly throughout the year. We undertook the piles of paper work required by our much valued subvention agency the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, without whom our activities would be severely restricted. We managed most of the time to keep to their deadlines for financial requests and reports and have had some success in obtaining their subvention for most of our international participations.

We also much appreciated the sponsorship for our youth development team from Honour Quality Ltd., Suzuran Bed (HK) Ltd. and Henselite.

Our Hong Kong Team selection process using the A and B squad systems, was fully implemented this last year with the A squad attending the world and asia-pacific competitions and the B squad to the asian and local competitions.

All in all, we, the Executive Committee have had a very frantic, yet productive year.

On the International front, we sent teams to the 2nd Singapore International Championships, 5th Asian Bowls Championship & 3rd Asian Under-25 Singles Championship, 1st China Invitational Tournament, invitational Michael Ashton-Philips International Cup, World Singles Champion of Champions, 12th Asia Pacific Bowls Championship, 1st Lion City Youth International Championship, World Cup & World Junior Cup (indoor singles), and locally the International Bowls Classics, Tiger Bowls and HKFC Mixed Fours tournaments. Sending our teams to these events entails a lot of work by our Association and our appreciation and thanks go to those few who have helped us as volunteers with the arrangements. Also many thanks to our volunteer markers and umpires at our local events. Please all remember that we welcome any assistance from you, all our members at any time.

And so in closing, Congratulations to all our last year's Winners and to the Losers, keep trying as this may be your year to be a Winner.

The Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2006

Irish and South Africans Sing the Song of Triumph

After celebrating its Jubilee in 2005, the Hong Kong International Bowls Classic resumed normal business in 2006. Sponsored by Zhong Gang Zhi Ye, this year's competition was held at three different clubs, the Singles at the Hong Kong Football Club and the Indian Recreation Club, and the Pairs at the Craigengower Cricket Club.

To accommodate international competitions, the competition took place weeks later than the usual schedule of mid November, from December 9 to 17. Players from 10 countries, including Brunei, China, England, Ireland, New Zealand, Scotland, Singapore, South Africa, USA and Wales, made their trip to Hong Kong to play against each other and the finest from Hong Kong.

THE SINGLES

Not much surprise in the first few rounds in the Singles competition, with only two overseas players falling at the first hurdle: Lohman Hj Salleh was defeated by Bernard Young of the Hong Kong Football Club and Li Ying Qin from China was beaten by Robin Chok of CCC. In the second round, defending champion Paul Girdler (New Zealand) was ousted by Welshman Gareth Thomas, who progressed to the quarter-finals after beating South African Neil Burkett in the third round.



Four other UK bowlers joined Thomas in the quarter-finals, including his compatriot Mike Prosser, Irishman Jeremy Henry, Scottish youngster Wayne Hogg and England's Mark Walton, the 2004 champion. The remaining quarter finalists were local hopes George Chan (HKFC), Robin Chok and James Cheng (HK).

Henry reached the last four with an 8-2, 7-3 win over Thomas, while Walton ended Welsh hopes by beating Prosser 6-5, 6-7, 2-1. Hogg beat George Chan 7-2, 8-4 while Chok beat Cheng 6-4, 8-1.

Hogg clinched his place in the final with a 2-7, 7-3, 2-0 win over Walton and Henry beat Chok comfortably at 8-2, 5-4.





The final, played at Hong Kong Football Club, was a close and entertaining encounter but it was the Irishman's greater experience that carried the day, as Henry prevailed 6-5, 7-6, 2-0.

THE PAIRS

Henry's hopes of performing a rarely achieved double were dashed in the Pairs final, when he and teammate Paul Daly were edged out 18-13 by South Africa's Wayne Perry and Neil Burkett. This is the second Pairs titles won by Burkett, who was playing his 10th Classic. In addition to the two titles he has won, Burkett was also on the receiving end of four Pairs finals and two Singles finals.

Played at the Craigengower Cricket Club, the South Africans started their group campaign with a defeat at the hands of Scotland's Wayne Hogg and Neil Speirs. Then they lost only one more time before reaching the final with knockout wins over England's Ian Honnor and Mark Walton (14-10) and KBGC's Heron Lau and Noel Kennedy (18-13).

Daly and Henry reached the final with wins of 17-16 and 22-15 over Lee Ka Ho and Ken Chan (HKLBA) and New Zealand's Matt Gallop and Paul Girdler respectively.

The stars of the event were undoubtedly the young Scottish duo Hogg and Speirs, who swept through their group with 11 wins in as many matches, and a shots credit of +138. Instantly installed as favorites for the title, they slipped up in the quarter-finals against the Kiwis, who had struggled in their group and qualifying for the knockout phase merely on shots difference.

At the group stage, rain affected the tournament and three sessions on Thursday were played at the indoor greens in Ap Lei Chau, Hong Kong Football Club, Craigengower Cricket Club and also the outdoor artificial green at the Hong Kong Police Officers' Club. Fortunately, the weather turned back to normal and the last two days of the competition was played under bright sunshine, ensuring an enjoyable atmosphere for both the participants and the many spectators.



Report on The 12th Asia Pacific Bowls Championship 2007



This Championship took place from 11-21 January 2007 at the Burnside and Fendalton Bowling Clubs in Christchurch, New Zealand. The weather was generally fine and hot, ranging around 23 degrees C, with some wind, and rain during only 1 session. The competition venues had 3 natural grass greens each with speeds averaging 16.5 seconds.

There were 17 participating countries namely, Australia, Brunei, Canada, China, Cook Islands, Fiji, Hong Kong, Japan, Malaysia, New Zealand, Norfolk Island, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Samoa, Singapore, Thailand and United States of America totaling 161 nos. of players. Not all countries managed to have teams in every discipline.

Report of The 5th Asian Lawn Bowls Championship 2006 & The 3rd Asian Under 25 Singles Lawn Bowls Championship 2006



This Championships took place from 12th to 18th August 2006 in Brunei. The competition site was at the Bandar Seri Begawan multi-sports complex, containing 2 artificial grass greens, situated about 10 kilometers from the main city centre. The green speed was maintained at around 16 seconds.

All members of the Asian Lawn Bowls Federation countries were invited to send teams of maximum 5 men and 5 women players for the open championship comprising 4 disciplines of play and for the under-25 years of age singles championship a maximum of 2 men and women. Also invited was 1 man and 1 woman manager.



Hong Kong was also invited to send an international umpire (we provided Michael Chow), to assist the organisers. The youth development team's co-ordinator and coach, Eric Chan, also attended.

There were 8 participating countries namely, Brunei, China, Hong Kong, Japan, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore and Thailand; but not all managed to have teams in every discipline. Of all the Federation member countries, Korea, Indonesia and India were unfortunately unable to participate.


