### Notes to Player

#### Reporting Time and Schedule

All teams including those with a bye in the 1<sup>st</sup> session are required to report to the Duty Official with a minimum of 4 players **before the time listed below**. Late-comers will forfeit their first match.

**16<sup>th</sup> July 2022 (Saturday)**

**ALC = 11:40 am**

**CCC, CdeR, FC, IRC, KBGC, KCC, SLY, TKO, USRC & VP = 9:10 am**

**17<sup>th</sup> July 2022 (Sunday)**

**Remaining round-robin games at CCC = 9:10 am**

**Quarter-finals at CCC, HKFC & IRC = 1:10 pm**

#### Dress Code

**16<sup>th</sup> July – Current Club Uniform**

**17<sup>th</sup> July – Event Polo-shirt**

Substitutes who do not have the event polo-shirt should wear their representing teams' club uniform during the games.

#### Scorecards

Pre-printed scorecards with match details and full list of home and away team players will be handed out by the duty official before each round.

Prior to the start of each game, teams with 5 players are required to check and cross off one of the player's name on the scorecard pending on their line-up.

The duty official must be notified of any substitution prior to the start of a match. The scorecard will be updated accordingly by the duty umpire before the match.

For any teams who registered with 5 players, please be reminded of the following condition of play:

“Players in any teams of 5 must play at least one game during the round-robin stage. Failure to comply with this rule will result in losing their right for the consolation prize or advance to the knock-out stage if applicable.”

Both skip are responsible to check that all information on the scorecard is correct. Once the scorecard is signed, the information captured on the card is final.

### Refreshment Arrangement

16<sup>th</sup> July – Sponsored drinks will be offered in the morning.

Players are reminded to observe the “No outside food” policy (sponsored snack included) at individual private venues.

Teams ranked from 1<sup>st</sup> to 48<sup>th</sup> qualify for the knock-out stage on 17<sup>th</sup> July. You must make all necessary efforts to be ready for the start of the Quarter-final at 1:30 pm. The duty umpire at the QF venues has the discretion to disqualify any team who fails to arrive at a reasonable time.

Teams ranked from 49<sup>th</sup> to 64<sup>th</sup> will be awarded consolation prize at the presentation ceremony after the Finals at CCC.
