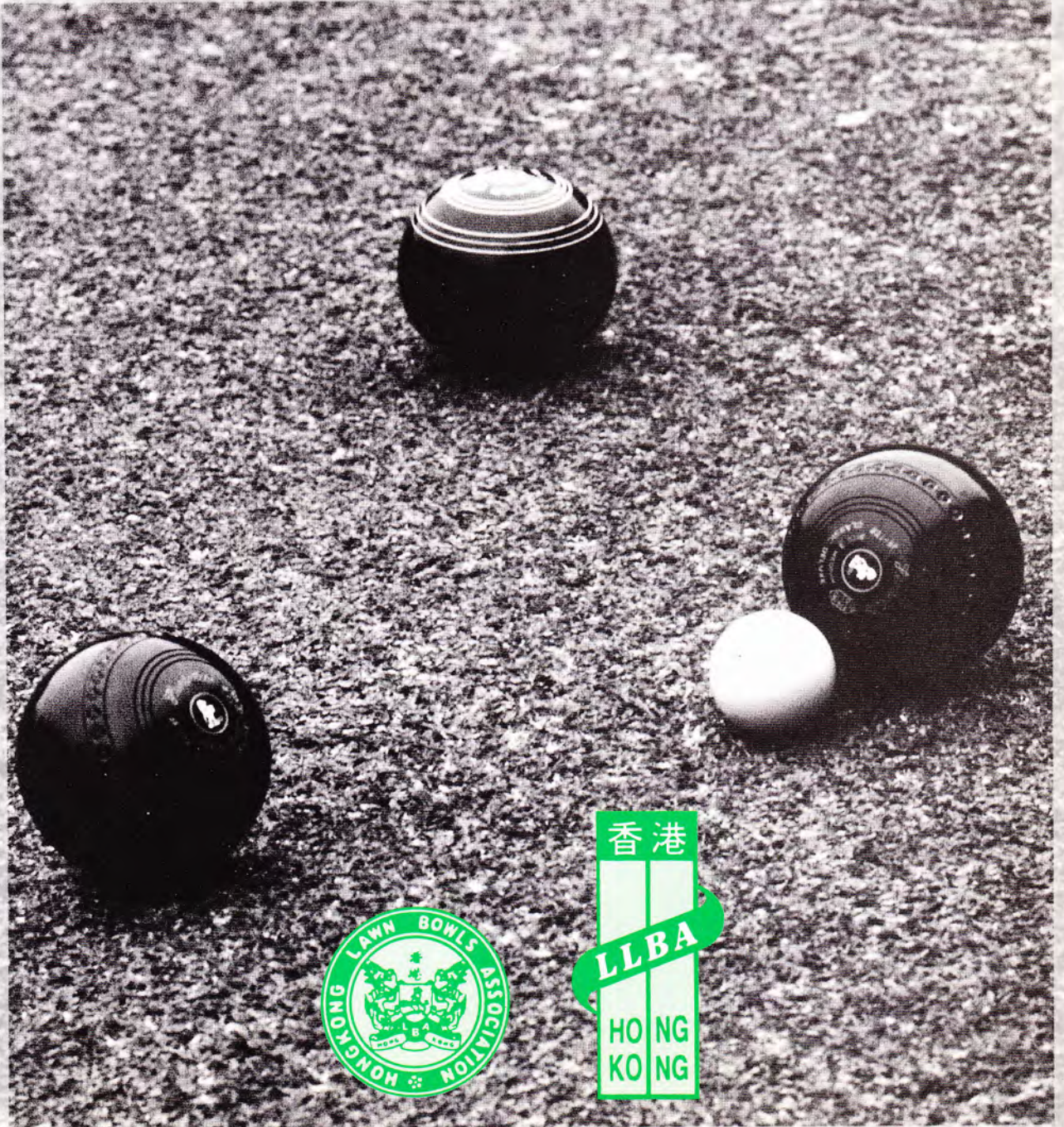

Report from Hon. Secretary H.K.L.B.A.

The main event of the year was the World Bowls competition held at Worthing with the Hong Kong team being represented by Mark McMahon, Noel Kennedy, George Souza Jnr., David Tso and Mel Stewart. Twenty nine countries took part, the greatest number ever. After the team's excellent performance in the Pacific Games, held the previous year, expectations were quite high of achieving good results in this competition. As it turned out the team just missed out on a chance for a medal in the triples, finishing third in their group and 5th. after the play-offs. Overall Hong Kong finished eighth, above Australia and New Zealand, a very creditable performance in what was a very strong field.

Strenuous efforts were made during the year to revive the International Classic Pairs competition. Although small amounts of sponsorship money were reasonably easy to come by, a large sponsor could not be found to make the event viable and regrettably the idea had to be dropped. Efforts will be made again in 1993.

On the domestic scene the "Grants" National Summer League continued to be sponsored by Messrs. Hiram Walker Wines & Spirits, importers of Grants Whisky, and as always, was keenly contested. A total of 41 teams entered from the 14 Clubs and congratulations are due to the respective winners of each division, First — Kowloon Cricket Club 'A', Second — China Light & Power 'A', Third — Royal Hong Kong Police 'B', and Fourth — City Lawn Bowls Club 'A'.

The National Winter League was without a sponsor but proved to be an equally enjoyable competition with 24 teams taking part. Congratulations go not only to the league team winners, First — Filipino Club 'A', Second — Kowloon Bowling Green Club 'A', and Third — Club de Recreio but also to the respective discipline winners. Thanks is also extended to the League Sub-committee, chaired by Brian Poynton, for the efficient organisation of both Leagues.

The National Competitions programme has been successfully completed and thanks are due to the Sub-committee, chaired by Vincent Cheung, in this respect. Congratulations are also due to all winners and finalists.

The \$10 million re-development by the Urban Council of the bowling greens at Victoria Park was finally completed early in the year. The two artificial greens, a new club house (with toilets and showers) and floodlighting have made a big difference, not only to CLBC and VLBC, but also to the coaching courses which the HKLBA run in conjunction with the Urban Services Department. These courses, which are run on Sundays and at least two evenings, still prove to be very popular and thanks must be given to the Chief Coach, Noorie Razack and his team of 32 coaches for their invaluable time and effort.

An interesting recent development in the sport is the decision by the Urban Services Department to purchase a number of short mats for the indoor games halls on the Kowloon side. Noorie and his team have already started coaching courses and organising competitions on behalf of the USD, and it is hoped that the public who start with the short mat will, in time, progress onto the full size version. With public facilities limited to Victoria Park it is encouraging to see a Government Department taking the initiative and bringing lawn bowls to a wider audience.

On the horizon, lawn bowls is expected to move into the New Territories with the start in 1993 on the construction of two bowling greens in Sha Tin. An artificial surface, similar to Victoria Park, will be provided and work is expected to be completed some time in 1995. This will provide further opportunities for the expansion of the sport.

Also on the move in 1994 will be the HKLBA office. The current rather small and cramped office in Queen Elizabeth Stadium, Wanchai is shared with the Ten Pin Bowling Association. New accommodation has been offered by the Sports Development Board in the Sports House which is part of the re-development of the Hong Kong Stadium in So Kon Po. A room will be provided for the use of both the HKLBA and HKLLBA and should see an improvement in the overall administration of the sport.

Finally, Beryl Pickford, the HKLBA's Sports Executive left for Australia in July closely followed by her husband Roger in September. Roger had served on the General Committee for ten years being Hon. Treasurer for the majority of the time and at the last AGM he also took on the role of Hon. Secretary. With Roger's departure Charles Ko of KBGC was co-opted onto the General Committee to fill the post of Hon. Treasurer and I assumed the post of Hon. Secretary. The job of Sports Executive has still to be filled.

Yeung again for their smooth administration of the schedule. Our thanks also to all the clubs and their Conveners for making rinks available throughout the year for these matches.

On the international scene, our ladies competed in the VII Womens World Championships in Ayr, Scotland in June 1992, a short report of which appears elsewhere in this publication.

The Blind Bowlers also enjoyed a successful year with two bowlers being invited to a Singles event in Kobe, Japan in October 1992 from which Mr C.M. Antunes brought home a Gold Medal. We should here record appreciation for the continued dedication and hard work put in by Ms. L. Yeung in this respect.

The H.K.L.B.A. are to be thanked for their continued support and cooperation and finally, I would like to pay tribute to the General Committee for their time and efforts throughout the year in organising and supporting the various events and functions.

We trust that the coming season will prove to be a happy and successful one for you all.

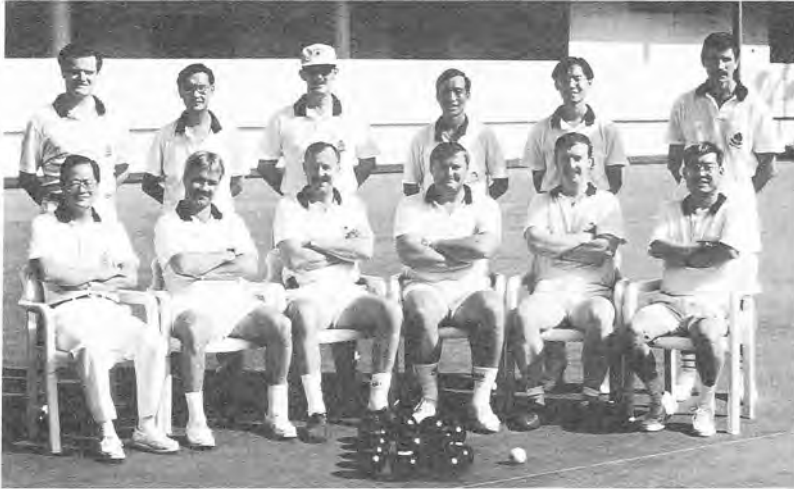

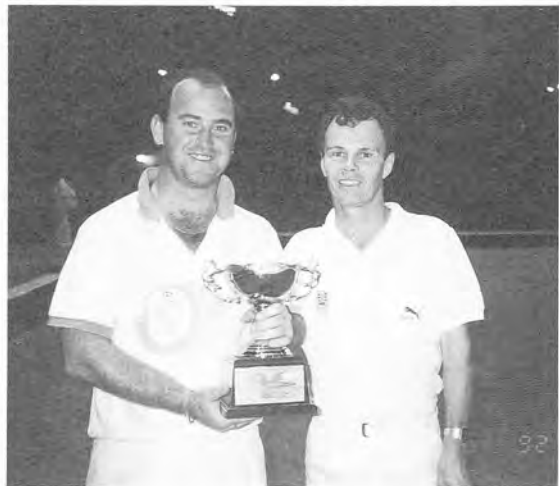

Report of Manager Mens World Bowls 1992

The World Championships of 1992 were hosted by the English Bowling Association at the excellent facilities at Worthing on the South Coast of England and were generously sponsored by the Woolwich Building Society.

After the usual deliberations our selectors nominated the same personnel who had acquitted themselves so well at the Mazda Pacific Bowls Championships though the line-up in the various disciplines had some important changes. Mark McMahon retained the Singles spot but the Pairs responsibility was assumed by Mel Stewart (lead) and David Tso (skip). The Triples therefore had George Souza Jr at skip with Mark McMahon at lead and Noel Kennedy at number 2. In the Fours the formation was Mel, David, Noel and George. Dennis Blyth was chosen to continue as team manager and it was unfortunate that, having done all the groundwork, pressure of work forced him to stand down, Bill McMahon assuming the position of manager. We had high hopes for such a strong team and in the event we were not to be disappointed.

The team was able to arrive a week early for acclimatisation and practice at the delightful host club of Kingston and East Preston where we shared the facilities with South Africa who seemed to have a large local following. Once the tournament started, however, the weather changed from being hot, sunny and windy to cold, miserable and windy. The fact that our hotel rooms did not have air-conditioning or fridges (our team could not believe this) did not eventually matter. It was also unfortunate that the distribution of teams to hotels, with the British teams together in one superior hotel and separate from all the other sides, seemed to cause some unnecessary polarisation, aggravated by some rather odd decisions during the tournament in favour of England. The Championships were certainly top heavy with officials of one kind or another. There were 1400 in total with 5 retained full-time from the turn of the year to complement the EBA staff. This for a tournament which, as far as players and matches were concerned, was only marginally more complex than the successful Pacific Bowls held in Hong Kong. As a whole the tournament was very well run and a credit to the EBA.

Large crowds attended despite the unseasonal weather and there was a definite, but unavoidable advantage, to England since crowd control dictated that they played in front of the largest grandstand each time and therefore on similar rink settings. The stands were, in fact, too near the play, and on a long end towards the stand spectators found their view obliterated by the front row. Hong Kong had a large, vociferous support and it was great to see so many old faces including such recent noteables as Past-President Harry Turner and George Sperring who worked so hard to ensure the success of our own international tournaments. The team was much saddened to learn of the death during the tournament of old friend Len Dick who passed away just as he was making preparations to come and support the team.

The Hong Kong team performed very well indeed, making many friends and being superb ambassadors throughout. Aspects of their play, conduct and demeanour met with favourable comments from opponents, officials, spectators and especially from the host club who turned out in numbers to support Hong Kong in all kinds of weather.

In the Singles Mark's eighth place did not tell the whole story and he certainly deserved to finish higher, being denied the rub of the green at various important stages. David and Mel played well and, indeed, led in most of their games including against the all-conquering Scots and were not flattered in finishing fifteenth. The Triple had a wonderful time and can be considered dreadfully unlucky not to finish with a medal. Their fifth place reflects an outstanding performance the highlight of which was a fine victory over the host country. The Fours were in the running for a medal play-off up to the final game, eventually claiming seventh place. Overall Hong Kong finished in eighth place, above Australia and New Zealand, a creditable performance of which we can be justifiably proud.

A special mention must be made of the sponsorship in the form of tracksuits and bowls bags generously donated by ANZ Bank for which the team was extremely grateful.

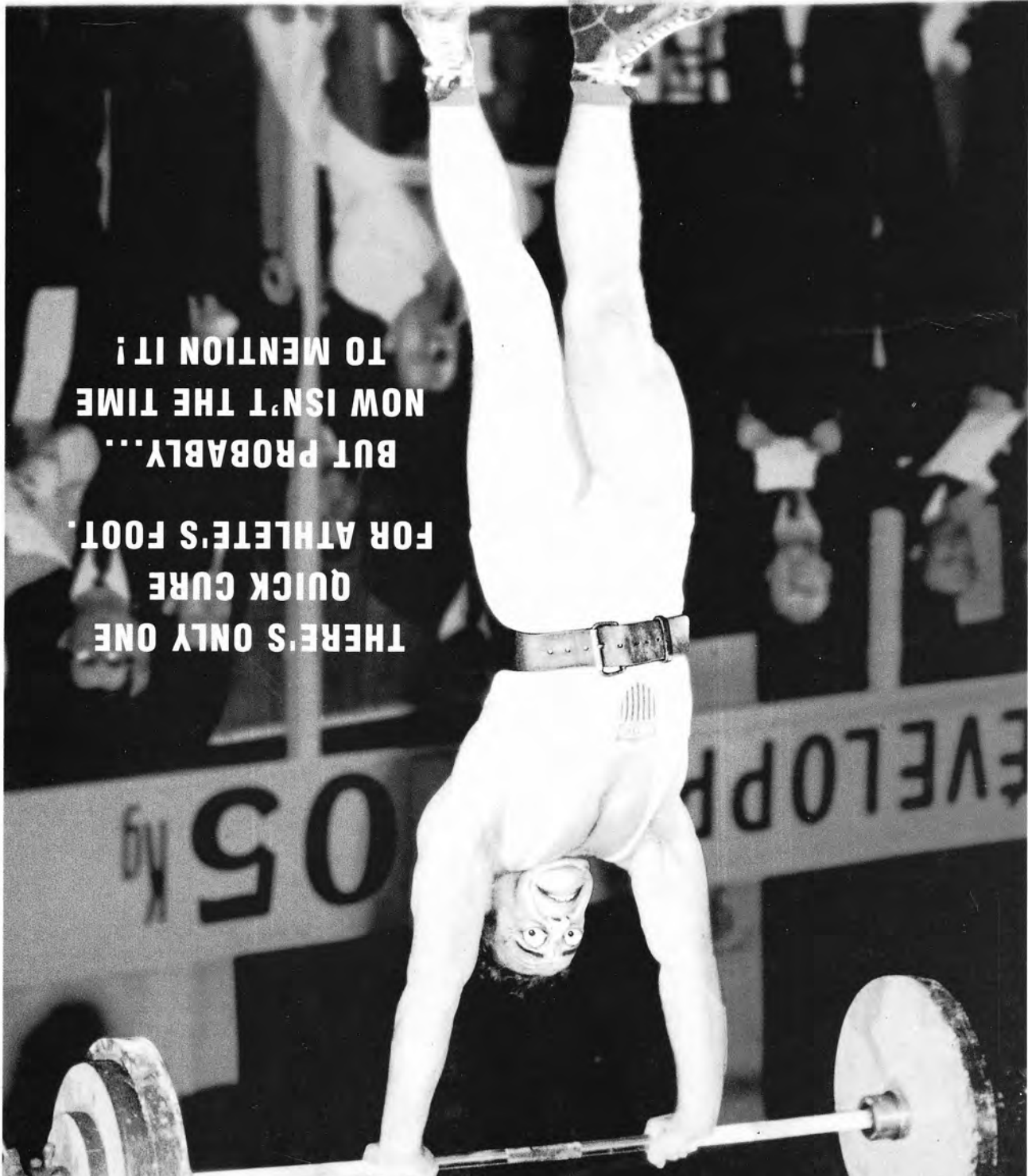
