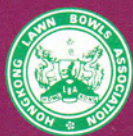

On the green Noel Kennedy set the standard with impressive performances at the World Indoor Championships which culminated in his being ranked 13th in the world. The Hong Kong China team of Noel, Willie Lai, James Cheng, Adam Poynton and Anthony Carstairs competed against the world's best in World Bowls 2000 and finished in a very credible 9th place.

The Association sent Tony Tong, James Cheng and Chi-Chi Fernandes to Scotland's Millennium Tournament. Tony was also our representative at the WIBC tournament in Ireland. We also had credible performances by the teams participated in the Tan Sri Ahmad Sarji Cup and the Bowls Malaysia Millennium Tournament. Nelson To, Jacky Wong, Jimmy Chiu, David Ng and Darwood Karamdin represented us in Brunei. Willie Lai, Simon Chan and David Tso were our players in Malaysia.

Off the green the LBA voted in favour of joining World Bowls Inc and agreed to be a member of the newly formed regional Association named Bowls Asia. By being members of both our participation in international competition will continue. I am delighted to report on the progress made in our joint effort with HKLLBA, Po Leung Kuk and the Education Department to introduce lawn bowls to the youth of Hong Kong. Some of the secondary school boys and girls are showing real promise which can only be good for the future of bowls. I must also mention the development of bowls in China, this year we had players from Shenzhen and Guangzhou appearing in the Classic singles.

My sincere thanks to our Patron, Dr. Stanley Ho, for his generous support to the Association. Likewise, Kowloon Bowling Green Club for sponsoring the Classic in their centenary year and to the Hong Kong Sports Development Board without whose help we would struggle to survive. I am also indebted to the members of my committee, league and championship panel members, club convenors, selectors, coaches and umpires for their efforts and support during the year.

Last, but by no means least, I would like to congratulate the prizewinners and hope all have an enjoyable evening.

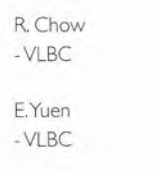

Kowloon Bowling Green Club Centenary Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2000

With sponsors hard to come by for the Hong Kong Classic, local club KBGC stepped in to the void by agreeing to sponsor and host the event in their centenary year. The greens at KBGC had suffered during the previous winter; however a marvellous effort by the green keepers brought the playing surface up to its usual high standard. After having seen a few 'rain dances' in the previous months, the Gods went overboard and drenched Hong Kong with a little too much rain. Rain caused the postponement of the club's own anniversary celebrations in August and tried to dampen the spirits of the organisers and players during the Classic.

Number one seed and triple defending singles champion Adam Jeffrey of Australia was hoping for an unprecedented fourth title. However David Tou of Hong Kong Football Club did not read the form guide and upset the Australian by beating him by 13 shots in the first round. Englishman Ian Bond took advantage of this by then beating Tou and proceeding to the semi-final. Along the way he beat Gary Mackie, the tall Scot who had taken the scalps of leading Hong Kong players Pat Chan and Anthony Carstairs.



Malaysian bowls has come along way over the past few years and M Adif Abdullah Daud showed the reason with victories over Henry Chow (KCC), Bill McMahon (HKFC) and big Bobby Donnelly of South Africa. In the same quarter of the draw, Peter Bellis was giving a display of fine bowling in despatching Johnny Ng (FC), Andrew Fleming

(Wales) and former finalist Willie Lai of CCC. In the last eight the Kiwi stopped the run of the young Malaysian, who was voted Personality of the Tournament for his infectious smile on the green.



Two places in the main draw of the singles were reserved for players from China where bowls has started across the border from Hong Kong. Lai Da Zhong and Lim Chiu Ning beat local players in their

first round matches. Lai beat Peter Li (VLBC) before losing out former pairs champion David Tso of CCC. Lim met David Harding in the second round, and went down to a 'man on a mission' 21-8. Harding then met one of the pre-tournament favourites Brett Duprez of Australia who was making his first visit to the Classic. The Welshman won the battle and went on to the quarter-finals. Singles champion of 1995 Noel Graham beat Mike Galloway of New Zealand and Tso before losing out Harding.

Hong Kong number one Noel Kennedy started with victories over difficult George Chan (HKFC) and Zimbabwean Robbie Robison. This gave him another game against a player from South Africa and crowd favourite Neil Burkett. Noel moved through to the quarterfinals to meet George Sneddon of Scotland after beating the Cape Town player. Sneddon played three local players on the first day including a long battle late in the evening against Chi Chi Fernandes. With the game getting longer this gave Chi Chi a chance to play to the ever-growing local crowd. Eventually the Scot won by one shot in a game that had everything including the Recreio bowler employing the Tiger Woods

finger raising when he knew he had the shot. Sneddon went off a relieved man and rested before a quarter-final victory against Kennedy in which the Hong Kong player gave his opponent an early 9-0 start.

Peter Bellis showed off more of his stylish delivery in his semi-final victory over Ian Bond. The other semi-final was a different affair with David Harding going off like a train, as he had done in his previous games, before coming off the rails and being overtaken by George Sneddon. The Scotsman's more consistent play gave him victory and a place in the final against the Kiwi.

The finalists were the only two current world champions in the 64-entry field. Bellis skipped the New Zealand triple that included Rowan Brassey and Andrew Curtain, whilst Sneddon was the lead for Alex Marshall in the pairs. Sneddon started well and went into a 5-0 lead before Bellis responded with two triples to get back to 8-6. After 20 ends the pair were locked at 16-all. The Kiwi then took a three and single to appear to be in command. George did not capitulate and responded with a single and two doubles to take the title.

The pair's competition is still considered one of the premiere competitions in the world and holders Jonathan Ross and Noel Graham of Ireland were looking to retain the trophy.

The weather for the week had been getting gradually worse, although the singles was played in glorious sunshine and slightly warm for some of the players. The games on Tuesday were suspended due to



steady rain, a result of Typhoon Bebinca, which had sat off shore threatening problems for days. The Tuesday schedule was finished on Wednesday, leaving the Thursday insurance policy to cover for the scheduled Wednesday games. Canada had realised there may be problems and sent Alan Webster (Pacific Games Singles Gold Medallist) who works as a meteorologist and plays bowls in his spare time.

The games in the early part of the week did not go according to plan for some teams whilst a few local teams upset the formbook by inflicting defeats on overseas pairing. The Irish pair beat the other international teams in their section but lost out to Filipino Club then snatched a draw against HKCC and still managed to finish top of the section. South Africa were on top of their game and suffered defeats only at the hands of the Irish and the official Hong Kong pair of Adam Poynton and James Cheng. With their defeat of Burkett and Donnelly in the last game, Poynton and Cheng moved to third in the section, after looking out of qualifying with early defeats by Ireland and New Zealand. Scotland who always seem to leave it late in qualifying for the quarter-finals were always in control of their games bar a few hiccups along the way although with a final game loss to Ireland had to settle for fourth place in the section. Hong Kong Cricket Club enjoyed their week with good performances and were unlucky to miss out on qualifying by one point. All in all a polished accomplishment for Andrew Robertson who has played in numerous Classics without success. The big upset of the group was the losses suffered by New Zealand who only pulled it together in the latter stages and finished with more losses than victories.

The other section included Australia, Wales, England and local hopes KBGC. Early on England looked like bowing out before they had even started to warm up, suffering early defeats at the hands of KBGC and the HKLBA pair; KBGC also laboured initially and late victories were not enough to garner enough points for qualification. Australia, Wales and Malaysia looked like making the top three spots in the group, before England stormed back with eight consecutive victories after switching positions. Malaysia lost late games and missed out on the quarterfinals with Zimbabwe pipping everyone else for the final spot.



The quarter-final line up gave some tantalising games with Australia playing Scotland, Wales matching up against South Africa, Zimbabwe playing holders Ireland and England against Hong Kong. With only a few ends to go the semi-finalists looked like being Australia, Wales, Zimbabwe and England. The other teams did not lie down and stormed back to record big victories. Australia held off the late charging Scots to move through, whilst South Africa scored seven shots in the last four ends to beat Wales. Ireland were 15-19 down with five ends to play however an eight

shot finish gave them the game and a semi-final berth against Hong Kong. The local pair were struggling against revitalised Holt and Bond but an 11 shot burst was sweet revenge for Poynton who had lost to Bond in the World Indoor singles earlier in the year at Potters.

Overnight rain flooded the KBGC greens and a decision was made to move the last three games to the indoor venue at Hong Kong Football Club. Purists will say that this was a little unfair on some players, but in the end the tournament was completed, albeit on an unfamiliar surface.

Ireland changed positions with indoor specialist Jonathon Ross moving to skip and allowing Noel Graham to draw to a bare jack. Against the HK pair they never looked like losing and a place in the final was there for the taking after an 18-8 score line. The game on the next rink was a sight to watch with fast green specialists Australia taking on South Africa, who do not have an indoor venue. The pair from the country that hosted the World Championship earlier in the year never allowed the young Ozzies in the game and the white flag was waved after only 13 of the allowed 18 ends, with the score reading 24-4.



The final was played before a packed crowd and even though Burkett was playing with a bandage on an infected toe, he still managed to claw his way back from 7-1 down to draw level at 13. A big finish by the defending champions gave them five shots in the final three ends to record a repeat victory in the Classic pairs.

World Bowls Championships 2000 *Manager's Report*



The 9th World Bowls was staged in Johannesburg, South Africa from 29 March to 15 April 2000. Twenty-four nations took part including Argentina, Botswana, Australia, Canada, England, Fiji, Guernsey, Hong Kong China, Ireland, Israel, Jersey, Malaysia, Namibia, New Zealand, Norfolk Island, Papua New Guinea, Scotland, Singapore, South Africa, Swaziland, United States of America, Wales, Zambia, Zimbabwe. Papua New Guinea withdrew in last minutes due to visa problems.

The Hong Kong SAR China team was represented by Noel Kennedy in the Singles who teamed up with Anthony Carstairs in the Pairs. The Triples were Willie Lai, Adam Poynton, James Cheng. The line up of the Fours was Willie Lai, Adam Poynton, Anthony Carstairs and James Cheng.

There was an impressive Opening Ceremony on 31 March at Marks Park Bowling Club, where all the participating teams headed by their national flags paraded on the green and were cheered by the big crowd of spectators. There were performances by singers and native dancers to mark the birth and unification of the country. Speeches were delivered by some of the distinguished guests and the President of the World Bowls Board.

Pairs

Noel and Anthony suffered two defeats in the opening session of the Pairs to Ireland 13-27 and to Australia 23-24. In the latter game Hong Kong were leading 13-0 after 3 ends but Australia fought back to 23-21 on 20 ends and then took a good 3 shots to beat Hong Kong 24-23. The Hong Kong duo bounced back from this disappointment to register consecutive wins over Fiji 31-16, Malaysia 22-11, Zambia 23-16, Botswana 26-16, Argentina 28-7, New Zealand 23-15 and a walk over Papua New Guinea. In the second last crucial game against Jersey, the Hong Kong pair were unable to settle on the heavy green and lost 1-1-1 in last 3 ends to be beaten by 16-19. Although Hong

Kong managed to beat Guernsey 22-13 in the last game they were unable to reach the semi-finals as New Zealand topped the section with 18 points followed by Australia with 17 points. In the semi-finals, South Africa beat New Zealand 22-17 and Scotland edged Australia 19-17. Scotland beat South Africa for Gold, South Africa got Silver while New Zealand and Australia both in joint Bronze.

Hong Kong finished third in the section and were ranked 5th overall in the pairs competition.

Triples

The Hong Kong combination of Willie, Adam and James lost their opening triples game to Zambia 7-22 but came storming back in the evening to beat Wales 22-8. The Hong Kong trio were unlucky on second day losing their morning game to Ireland 11-22. In the afternoon game against South Africa who had a big crowd of supporters, the Hong Kong trio were completely dominated by South Africa who played magnificent bowls to win 42-4. Hong Kong beat Argentina 19-10 before losing to Canada 15-17, Namibia 10-25, Malaysia 14-20 and Scotland 4-28. We had a walk-over on Papua New Guinea and beat Botswana 27-10 in the final game. Scotland topped the section with 20



points followed by Ireland on 18 points. In the semi-finals, Australia beat Scotland 20-13 and New Zealand beat Ireland 16-13. New Zealand beat Australia 23-13 in the final for Gold, Australia won Silver while Scotland and Ireland won Bronze.

Hong Kong finished 9th in the section and ranked 18th overall in the triples tournament.

Singles

Noel got-off a good start by beating Guernsey 21-12 but lost two games which he had expected to win to John Price of Wales 13-21 and Swaziland 19-21. Noel lay game 19-19 in the latter match but his opponent drew the shot with his last bowl to 20-19 and got another shot in the following end to edge Hong Kong 21-19. Noel came back with three comfortable wins over Singapore 21-18, Norfolk Islands 21-16 and Jersey 21-10. The clash between Canada on Round 7 saw the Canadian beat Noel with brilliant drawing shots to win 21-12. Noel's defeat by his opponent undoubtedly cost him a medal. Noel recovered his solid form beat his main rivals in the section Jeff Rabkin of Israel 21-17, Steve Glasson of Australia 21-16, USA 21-11 and Andrew Curtain of New Zealand 21-13. The last game against New Zealand was most important which he had to win by 10 shots to give him a place in the semi-finals. However, the 8 shots win over New Zealand was not enough to carry him through as his closer rival Australia had a big margin win over Wales 21-5 and Israel down Guernsey 21-9. At the end of the sectional play, Australia, Israel, Hong Kong and New Zealand all had 8 points. The first two qualified due to better shots differences. In the semi-finals, Ireland beat Israel 21-13 and Australia beat England 21-16. Ireland beat Australia 21-14 in the final for Gold. Australia got Silver while Israel and England in joint Bronze.

Noel came third in the section and ranked 6th overall of the Singles event. It was most disappointing that Hong Kong's hope for a medal in the Singles were dashed by a 2 shot difference despite brilliant performances by Noel throughout the week.

Fours

The new combination of Adam, Willie, James and Anthony got off a good start in the first day of the Fours games defeated the favorites, Scotland from 14-18 deficit after 18 ends to score a 2-3-2 and win 21-18. They went down to Israel 15-21 in a close game in the afternoon but bounced back to beat Canada 22-17 in the evening. The Hong Kong Fours got a walk-over on Papua New Guinea. They had another win over Botswana 20-18 and an easy win over Fiji 29-16 before losing to Malaysia 21-23. England proved too strong for us on a controversial rink and won 26-11. In the last game, Hong Kong beat main rival New Zealand 24-15. Scotland topped the section with 17 points followed by New Zealand and Hong Kong both with 16 points but Hong Kong came third due to shot difference.

In the semi-finals, South Africa beat Scotland 20-8 and Wales beat New Zealand 23-19. Wales beat South Africa in the final for Gold, South Africa got Silver while Scotland and New Zealand in joint Bronze.

Hong Kong finished third in the section and ranked 6th overall in the Fours event.

At the end of the World Championships, Australia won the Leonard Trophy as overall winners. Hong Kong ranked 9th overall with 61 points maintaining the same position as in the last World Bowls Championships in Adelaide.

9th Women's World Bowls Championships 2000

Manager's Report

The Women's World Bowls Championships are held every four years under the control of the International Women's Bowling Board (IWBB). There are 35 countries affiliated with the IWBB, 34 of which are represented at the 9th Women's World Bowls Championships. They are Argentina, Australia, Botswana, Brazil, Brunei, Canada, Cook Islands, England, Fiji, Guernsey, India, Ireland, Israel, Japan, Jersey, Kenya, Malaysia, Namibia, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norfolk Island, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Scotland, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Swaziland, Thailand, U.S.A. , Wales, Zambia, Zimbabwe and Hong Kong China.

The event is held in a country which has a National women's bowling organization affiliated with the IWBB. The national authority nominates to hold the Championships in its country, stating details of its ability to stage and host the event. The 8th Women's World Bowls Championships were held in 1996 in England at Royal Leamington Spa and the next Championships will be held in Malaysia in 2004.



In 2000 the Australian Women's Bowling Council is the host for the Championships and Moama which is situated in New South Wales is selected as the venue because 5 greens with night lighting are required for 34 games to be in progress simultaneously. Another important aspect is that Moama Bowling Club has all of the ancillary requirements to cope with 170 competitors, 34 team managers and up to 60 officials acting in the areas of umpires, tournament control, security as well as the international delegates in the dining area and general clubhouse at any one time. The Australian Women's Bowling Council is responsible for staging and financing the event which is of 18 days duration, from 8 to 26 March 2000.



Each national team was comprised of 5 players accompanied by a manager: The Hong Kong China Ladies' team was represented by Anna Clarke in Singles, Danna Chiu and Anna Clarke in Pairs, Angela Chau, Linda Da Luz and Lena Yeung in Triples. The Fours were Angela , Danna, Linda and

Lena. I was appointed the Manager of the Team. All the 5 players selected based on the approved marking system were the top women bowlers in Hong Kong. It is therefore irrelevant to doubt or challenge their bowling technique, experience and etiquette. In addition, the Hong Kong China Team was repeatedly praised for their tidiness, very attractive uniform and excellent behavior: The players were polite, active and sociable in their contacts with other players and workers, and even the staff of Moama Bowling Club. They had successfully made themselves great ambassadors of Hong Kong. I am proud to be their manager.

At the end of the Championships competition, England was in the first overall position with 111 points. Hong Kong China was listed 20th with 60 points . Our best result achieved was the Fours which came 14th in this event's final standing. I would point out that this time our result was much improved when compared to the standing in the last IWBB Championships Tournament held in 1996.

In closing, I would like to take this opportunity to wish the Hong Kong China Ladies Bowling Team each and every success in the forthcoming Pacific Games scheduled to be held also in Moama, Australia in October, 2001.

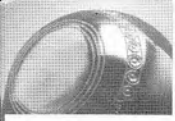
