在 2003-2004 年度，共有六個新球會加入香港草地滾球總會的大家庭，亦見證了大量新球員，特別是女性球員，參加了由總會舉辦的聯賽及公開賽。這明顯反映出當初將所有球員歸於同一總會旗下的決定已收到成效，雖然整個程序甚為冗長而且吃力，但在各位委員及屬會的支持下，我相信我們已成功達到目標。

現在讓我們先看看青少年發展計劃的情況。青年軍 "A" 隊繼續去年的佳績，在丁組取得亞軍，來季將會升上丙組作賽。在七月，祝鴻基、伍展力及羅婷芝代表香港參加了第一屆亞洲 25 歲以下青年錦標賽，這是多年來香港首次派出球員參加國際級青少年賽事。結果祝鴻基和伍展力分別取得銀牌和銅牌，而青年隊三名成員在比賽中的高水平表現及良好禮儀都得到其他國家參賽代表的一致讚賞。而總會在七月舉辦的另一次 25 歲以下新秀賽中，也選拔了一批新球員於十月組成一支新的男子青少年 "B" 隊及女子 "A" 隊。我特別多謝統籌青年軍活動的陳偉生先生及一群教練在發展青少年活動方面的貢獻，我們也感謝香港康體發展局、DHL 及 GSPM 的繼續支持和贊助。

年內，香港球員亦繼續積極參與主要的世界賽事。在愛爾蘭的世界室內草地滾球錦標賽中，香港球員黎維斌及馬彬在混合雙人賽打進準決賽；彭德在澳洲舉行的第一屆世界冠中之冠單人賽中取得第十名；肯尼迪在世界室內草地滾球單人錦標賽中亦取得佳績。在馬來西亞舉行的第三屆亞洲草地滾球錦標賽中，香港隊取得一金、三銀及兩銅的成績，而總成績則位列亞軍。在緊隨其後的第一屆歐亞對抗賽中，四名香港男子球員及一名女子球員也協助亞洲隊在男子單人賽、男子三人賽及女子三人賽擊敗歐洲隊。在十一月，香港隊出席了在澳洲舉行的亞太草地滾球錦標賽，結果男子隊共取得三枚銅牌，並在參賽十六國中排名第五，而女子隊則排名第九。

談到亞太草地滾球錦標賽，很遺憾香港因為爆發非典型肺炎而要放棄主辦這個重要賽事，幸好澳洲草地滾球總會願意臨危受命，接手主辦，令賽事可以延續。

在十月，我們的義務秘書廖以信先生在服務多年後請辭，我們謹向他多年來作出的貢獻致謝，亦希望他在毛里裘斯的反貪污工作能事事順利。另一件喜訊就是中國國家體委已批准中國申請加入世界草地滾球總會，我們預期他們很快就會成為世界草地滾球總會會員。

我亦借此機會鳴謝各位執行委員會成員、小組委員會成員、各球會的召集人、裁判及教練等，多謝他們在過去一年對聯賽及各公開賽的支持及貢獻。而最重要的就是要多謝香港康體發展局對總會的財政及行政支援。

最後，我衷心祝賀今晚各位得獎者，希望各位都享受一個愉快的晚上。

Message from The President

In the 2003-2004 season, we saw six new clubs joining the HKLBA and a large number of bowlers, in particular ladies, taking part in National and League competitions organized by us. This clearly indicates that our goal of having all our bowlers under one management has, despite the originally slow start, now proved itself worthy and our objective has been successfully accomplished, thanks to all our supportive and hardworking committees and members.

This year I would like to start off with a few words on our youth development. The "A" team continued their last year's Premier League success and finishing second in the Fourth Division, they will be promoted to the Third Division next season. In July 2003, Robin Chok, Jerry Ng and Tiffany Law represented Hong Kong in the 1st Asian Under 25 Championships. Though this was the first international event for our under 25's after a very long absence of Hong Kong from any of the International Under 25 tournaments, it will certainly not be the last. Robin and Jerry did well and came back with a Silver and a Bronze medal but all three of them won high praises from their Asian counterparts for their high standard of performance and excellent etiquette. In October, through a novice under 25 competition, new players were recruited and a boys "B" team and a girls "A" team were formed. My sincere thanks to the Youth Team coordinator Mr. Eric Chan and his team of coaches for their dedication and devotion, and my gratitude to the major sponsors of our youth team, the SDB, DHL and GSPM for their continuous support and contribution.

Hong Kong players continues their active participation in major World Championships. At the World Indoor Bowls Council Championships held in Ireland, Pat Lai and Peggy Ma reached semi-final in the Mixed Pairs. Adam Poynton took part in the 1st World Singles Champion of Champions 2003 held in Australia and came 10th overall. In the World Indoor Singles, Noel Kennedy continues to hold his own position against the World's best. The 3rd Asian Bowls Championships was held in Malaysia in July 2003, Hong Kong came back with one gold, three silver and two bronze medals, both men and ladies came second overall and once again, Hong Kong finished runners-up to Malaysia. Immediately following the Asian Championships, four men and one lady from Hong Kong were selected to participate in the 1st Asia vs Europe Bowls Classic. They beat the European team in Men's Singles, Men's Triples and Ladies Triples and won gold medal in all three disciplines. In November 2003, the Hong Kong Team took part in the 10th Asia Pacific Championships in Australia. The Men's team came back with three bronze medals and 5th overall out of 16 countries. Ladies team missed the chance of two bronzes and came 9th overall again out of 16 countries.

Talking about the Asia Pacific Championships, it was a pity that Hong Kong had to give up hosting this prestigious competition due to the outbreak of SARS in the months prior to the event. We are grateful to Bowls Australia who took this over on our urgent and late request. In October, we lost Jim Neilson, our Hon. Secretary who had served the Association for a number of years. His departure is a great lost to us but I wish him every success in furthering his anti-corruption career in Mauritius. One good news is China had informed us that their application to World Bowls had finally been approved by their National Sports Federation and we are looking forward to their World Bowls membership in the near future.

My gratitude also goes to the General Committee, various panel members, club convenors, umpires and coaches for their support and contribution in our National League and Championships games and in the running of the sport in the past year, and I am grateful to the Hong Kong Sports Development Board for their uninterrupted financial and administrative support.

Finally, I would like to congratulate all prize winners and hope that everyone has an enjoyable presentation dinner.

2003 至 2004 年度是一個值得懷念的年份，總會在年初時充滿熱誠地期盼主辦亞太草地滾球錦標賽，並向各參賽國發出邀請函。然後，非典型肺炎的爆發令不少國家都表達了關注的訊息，甚至質疑派隊的可能性。由於缺乏參賽國將對總會的財政造成重大負擔，總會在為長遠打算下，只好要求澳洲草地滾球總會接手主辦賽事。

在非典型肺炎肆虐之下，香港草地滾球總會仍然積極派隊參與海外賽事，包括世界室內草地滾球錦標賽、世界冠中之冠單人錦標賽、第三屆亞洲草地滾球錦標賽、第一屆亞洲25歲以下青年錦標賽及第十屆亞太草地滾球錦標賽等。亞洲草地滾球錦標賽及亞太草地滾球錦標賽將在年報中另行報導，我特別要提及青年球員祝鴻基和伍展力在第一屆亞洲25歲以下青年錦標賽所取得的傑出成就。

在本地賽事方面，香港草地滾球總會特別感謝所有參加各項賽事的球員，亦熱烈祝賀下列贏得聯賽錦標的隊伍：

The year 2003 - 2004 was memorable in more ways than one. The Association started the year full of enthusiasm and looking forward to hosting the Asia Pacific Championships. Invitations had been sent out before the dreaded SARS virus caused a number of countries to express concern and question the wisdom of sending their bowlers to Hong Kong. The financial repercussions involved in staging a competition without the full complement of eligible countries participating caused the Association to think long and hard before deciding to ask Bowls Australia to take over the Championships.

Despite the best efforts of SARS the Association still sent representatives to participate in overseas competition. Players and teams representing Hong Kong China participated in the World Indoor Bowls Council Championships, World Champion of Champions Singles, 3rd Asian Bowls Championships, 1st Asian Under 25 Singles Championships and the 10th Asia Pacific Bowls Championships. Reports on the Asian Championships and the Asia Pacific Championships appear elsewhere in the magazine. Special mention must be made of the achievements of Robin Chok and Jerry Ng in the 1st Asian Under 25 Championships.

On the home front the Association appreciates the efforts of all our bowlers who took part in both the Premier and Triples League. My congratulations go to the respective winners.

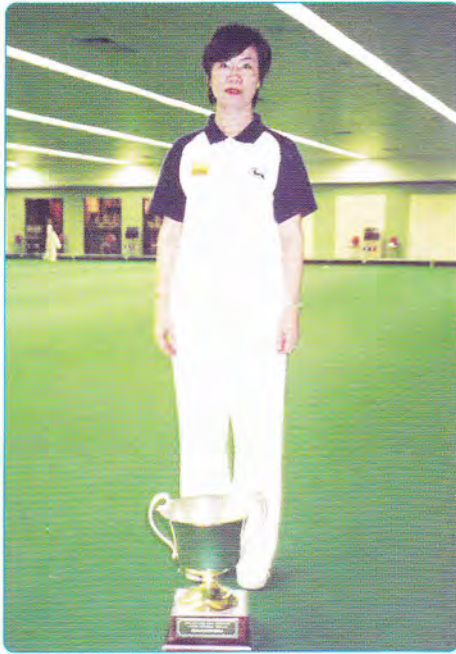

3rd Asian Lawn Bowls Championships

*Bukit Kiara, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia
3-17 July 2003*

The 3rd Asian Lawn Bowls Championships was held at the bowling stadium at Bukit Kiara which was located outside Kuala Lumpur. A total of 7 countries, namely, Malaysia (host country), Hong Kong, Philippines, Indonesia, Singapore, Thailand and Brunei took part in this competition. Originally, Japan, Korea and China were going to participate as well but for one reason or another, they did not come.



The government-owned Bukit Kiara Sports Complex had 5 grass greens. The greens were used on a rotation basis with the final rounds held on Green A as it was the only green that had spectator stands. The competition was on a round robin basis and consisted of Singles, Pairs, Triples, and Fours for men and women. Gold, silver and bronze medals were awarded to winners and runners-up of each discipline. There were also overall championships for men and women and combined.

The following is a brief description of the Hong Kong team's performance in each discipline. The competition started off with Pairs and Triples and then followed by Singles and Fours.

3rd Asian Lawn Bowls Championships

Men's Singles (21 points)

In all his 6 games, Adam lost one match (14-21) to Malaysia's Safuan who was ranked joint no.1 in Malaysia. In the match against Singapore, Adam dropped only one end and won 21-2. However, the result of the match against Thailand turned out to be rather surprising as the score was 20 all after 26 ends but Adam managed to win by one shot at last. The Thai player fought very hard and pro-





duced some fine shots. As Malaysia was beaten by Brunei, Adam, who had also lost only one match, clinched the Gold medal by having a better shots difference.

Men's Pairs (18 ends)

Adam (lead) and James (skip) had a good start by beating Brunei 19-11 and Philippines 23-15 on day one. In the match against the Philippines, they were leading 11-8 after 10 ends and picked up 12 shots (including a 7) in the next 4 ends to bring the score to 23-8 and built up a large cushion for winning the match even though they lost 7 shots in the last 4 ends.

On day 2, the Hong Kong pairs maintained their winning style in the first 2 matches by beating Singapore 16-12 and Thailand 25-13 but in the evening they lost to Malaysia 14-26. In the match against Malaysia, it was a very tense game and both teams played well. The score was 9 all after 9 ends but the Malaysian team surged ahead in the second half, picking up 17 shots in total.



On day 3, they played the final match which was against Indonesia. Although Adam and James only won 8 ends including a 7 and a 5, it was enough to win the match and a Silver medal in the overall men's pairs. The Gold went to Malaysia by having a better shots difference.



Men's Triples (18 ends)

In the opening match, our triples team comprising of Jimmy Chiu (lead), Willie Lai (second) and Danny Ho (skip) lost 11-17 to Brunei. The Brunei team was very accurate with their heavy shots throughout the game. When they were down, they ran into the head and most of the times they got the result that they wanted. As a result, we only won 6 out of the 18 ends. In the following game, we beat Philippines 17-12.

As Danny had to return to Hong Kong, he was replaced by C. M. Chan, the Assistant Team Manager, for the remaining matches. The substitution of Danny Ho with C. M. Chan brought about some fantastic results because the new combination of C. M. (lead), Jimmy (second) and Willie (skip) managed to overpower Singapore 19-12, Thailand 17-11, Malaysia 21-12 and Indonesia 24-12. Same as in the Men's Pairs, we had to settle for a Silver because again Malaysia who was on the same points had a better shots difference.

Men's Fours (18 ends)

The original line-up of the Hong Kong fours were Jimmy Chiu (lead), Willie Lai (second), Danny Ho (third) and James Cheng (skip) but after losing the first 2 matches against Brunei (13-20) and Philippines (12-18), it was decided to let Jimmy and Willie switch their positions with the hope of finding the winning format. The team then started to perform better and beat Singapore (15-12) and Thailand (21-13). In the crucial match against Malaysia, both teams won 9 ends each but Malaysia won by 19-16 despite our late come back. Overall, our Men's Fours team ranked 4th.

Women's Singles (21 points)

Angela started well securing three straight wins over Brunei (21-12), Philippines (21-17) and Singapore (21-3) with some convincing scores. Then luck went against her and she lost to Thailand (13-21) and Malaysia (14-21) in the next two rounds. The last round against Indonesia became decisive then for medals. A win for Angela would get her a Silver but a defeat would lose the Bronze. The young Indonesian girl Ana, subsequently named the "Indonesian Sensation", played very well and won the match (21-16) with the Silver and Angela ended up 4th overall.



Women's Pairs (18 ends)

Angela and Danna lost the 1st round to Brunei (14-18) after a long grueling game. They recovered their rhythm in the next three rounds and won over Philippines (12-9), Singapore (23-13) and Thailand (18-15). Then they lost to the strong Malaysian team (13-25) and beat the Indonesian (19-10) ended up with the Bronze.

Women's Triples (18 ends)

Anna, Hannah and Stephanie also started well securing three straight wins over Brunei (38-11), Philippines (18-10) and Singapore (20-11) with some convincing scores. Then they lost to Thailand (15-18) and Malaysia (9-37) in the next two rounds. They defeated Indonesia (17-12) in the last round to get the Bronze.



Women's Fours (18 ends)

Danna, Anna, Hannah and Stephanie started very well securing four straight wins over Brunei (12-11), Philippines (16-12), Singapore (25-5) and Thailand (13-12). The next round against Malaysia would be a match for the Gold and it ended up a draw (17-17) with a very close measure of shots in the last end. They went on to beat Indonesia (24-10) in the last round but ended up with the Silver losing the Gold to Malaysia by shots difference. It was such a pity to miss out the Gold as the team performed so well without losing a single match.

Overall Team Results

Hong Kong ranked second in the Men's Overall, Women's Overall and in the Overall Championship.



1st Asian Under 25 Singles Championship

Hong Kong was represented by Jerry Ng and Robin Chok in the Men's section and Tiffany Law in the Women's. In the preliminary round, Jerry came second in his group (each group consisted of 4 bowlers with the top 2 bowlers in each group qualifying for the semi's) and Robin played very well and finished on top in his group. So, in the semi-finals, they played against each other. Robin won the game and went into the final. Unfortunately, in the final, Robin did not play as well as he had in the earlier rounds and he could only manage a Silver medal. Being a losing semi-finalist, Jerry got a Bronze.



Tiffany played some very good shots but unfortunately her opponents were much stronger. Considering the relatively short time that Tiffany had been involved in this sport, her performance was quite pleasing. Given more exposure and more practices, she could only improve.

1st Asia Vs Europe Lawn Bowls Classic

After the conclusion of the 3rd Asian Lawn Bowls Championships, the Selection Panel of Bowls Asia started to form the Asian Team for the inaugural ASIA Vs EUROPE Lawn Bowls Classic that followed. The Asian Team, similar to the European Team, consisted of ten women and ten men. Out of the ten men selected, six were from Malaysia and four from Hong Kong, namely, Adam, Willie, Jimmy and C.M. Out of the ten women selected, also six were from Malaysia, two from Thailand, one from Indonesia and Stephanie from Hong Kong. The Asian Team won five out of total eight disciplines and clinched the overall Classic Trophy. All the five selected Hong Kong players secured individual Gold medals, i.e., Adam for Singles, Willie, Jimmy and C.M. for Triples and Stephanie for Women's Triples, skipping a Malaysian and the Indonesian. Prize Presentation/Farewell Dinner was held at the magnificent Kuala

Lumpur Golf and Country Club with some top-class musical performance. We all enjoyed the evening and departed with some warm and treasured friendships made during these bowls matches and may they be long lasting too.



In general, the competition was quite well run apart from a few confusions which the organizers were quick in resolving. We must admit that the overall results of the Hong Kong teams was slightly above our expectation although we could have done better in some of the disciplines, e.g. Men's Fours and Women's Singles had we had a little bit of luck.

The tropical heat and occasional thunder storm posed difficult playing conditions for all and our ladies managed to keep up their fighting spirit win-

ning one Silver and two Bronze ended up with Silver for Women's Overall, a result better than last year. Our ladies displayed good etiquette and sportsmanship throughout the tournament embracing valuable friendships at the end. The comradeship and team spirit among themselves were also admirable. The Women's Team's great efforts and the way they conducted themselves throughout this enjoyable tournament were deeply appreciated.



Although the whole team seemed to have performed quite well judging by the results, it did come to light that there was room for improvement on cooperation and understanding amongst players. We believed that most of our players had noticed that other countries were catching up and they also had some young bowlers who were showing a lot of potential.

It had to be admitted that the Malaysia Men and Women teams dominated the competition and won 6 Gold medals in the 8 disciplines. The Malaysian Lawn Bowls Federation now had 4 squads, i.e. the main team, the reserve team, the under-25 team and the under-18 team, and the players undergo trainings and practices all the time. And for this competition, they had been training for one month, 6 - 7 hours everyday, from Monday to Friday. The idea of having a fixed or regular national squad comprising of more than one group of bowlers was something that we should definitely consider for the continuous development and improvement of the sport in Hong Kong.

Staged at the Pine Rivers Memorial Bowls Club, Brisbane, Australia, from 25 November to 2 December 2003, the biennial Asia Pacific Bowls Championships featured teams from 16 nations including Hong Kong, Australia, Canada, Cook Islands, Fiji, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, New Zealand, Norfolk Island, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Samoa, Singapore, Thailand and USA. Each entered a male and female team of five competitors competing in singles, pairs, triples and fours.

After an intense series of practice and physical training sessions, the Hong Kong team headed for the competition in good form and aiming high, hoping to better the achievement of one gold, one silver and one bronze in the previous event.

After 10 days of competitions, the Hong Kong team returned with three bronze medals, all from the men's team. It appeared that part of the reasons for such result is because of an unfavourable draw in the competition, another was due to the lack of fighting spirit between players. Such disappointing results have triggered the call for a review of the current player selection/training system.

In the Men's Singles, Noel Kennedy was keen to defend his singles title and, on his road to the semi final, defeated bowlers from Cook Island, Papua New Guinea, Samoa and Philippines. During the semi final Noel was beaten by Russell Meyer, the New Zealander who eventually won the gold medal, and could only settle for a bronze.



In the Men's Pairs, the Hong Kong duol of Noel Kennedy and Adam Poynton did not face too much resistance in the early rounds, when they beat Fiji, Norfolk Island, Singapore and the USA easily. The semi final against Canada was a tight contest and at the end, the Canadians proved too strong for the Hong Kong pairs and again, Hong Kong had to settle for the bronze. Canada later won the gold in the event.



In the Men's Triples, the team of Danny Ho, James Cheng and Jimmy Chiu started badly, losing to the USA in the first game. A re-group saw the team defeat the Philippines convincingly, but a lose to the Cook Islands in the last game at the sectional level almost jeopardised their progress. With an advance to the next level with a superior shot difference, the team faced Fiji in the quarterfinal and played their best game of the event, beating the team by 36-7. The semi final against the Australian was a much tighter encounter and, although the Hong Kong trio played exceptionally well, at the end Hong Kong was the losing side. A bronze was a consolation prize for their effort.

The men's Fours, along with the ladies' Pairs and Triples, did not even get through the sectional stage.

The Ladies' Singles was represented by Danna Chiu, who won all the three round robin games in the sectional stage. In the quarter final she faced New Zealander Marlene Castle and was defeated in a somewhat unlucky fashion. Danna finished fifth, just missing out on a bronze medal.

In the Ladies' Fours, the team of Angela Chau, Hannah Ha, Stephanie Chung and Elizabeth Li went all the way until they faced New Zealand in the quarter final. The team gave a strong fight and at the end, was still not good enough to get through.

The overall ranking of the Men's and Ladies' teams dropped to 5th and 9th respectively, the lowest ever recorded by a Hong Kong team at the Asia Pacific Bowls Championships.

In 2001, the first youth team was formed from school students introduced to the sport by a joint schools and HKLBA programme. The team (Youth Team A), now comprises 17 youths aged from 16 to 22 years, and they continue with their regular training. Since joining the adults in the inter-club league and national competitions in 2001 they continue to progress, hold their own



and win games. They have worked their way up from the lowest league division and are now in Division 3 of 2004/05's premier fours league. They were also Division 4's 2nd and 6th best skips (Jerry Ng and Ken Chan) and the 4th, 7th, 9th and 10th best players, (Jerry Ng, C.S. Li, Kevin Yan and Y. H. Ng). For the Division 5 triples league, they came 2nd with good achievements attained in both best skip and player tables. Some have also teamed up with experienced adult members in our National Competitions. In the National Games, achievements were: runners-up in the Novice Pairs and Mixed Novice Fours; and winners in the Novice Singles, Under 25 Mixed Singles and Novice Singles. Their opponents were often very experienced and higher division bowlers. Jerry Ng performed very well at the 1st Asian Under 25 Singles Championships 2003 held in Malaysia this year, and narrowly missed out in the semi-final for a place in the final. However, his efforts helped to win our Association a spot in the 2004 World Indoor under 25 Championships in UK.

In year 2002 HKLBA introduced and continued in 2003, with 30 training courses specially targeted at the youth, as they are the future of our sport and has been recognized as such internationally, with lawn bowls being publicized in schools. Our courses commenced during the summer vacation time (August) and continued with intermediate classes. These courses were held at Victoria Park, Sai Wan Ho, Shatin and Ap Lei Chau and are continuing. A competition for these new bowlers was held in Ap Lei Chau in July this year at which members were selected for our boys 2nd Youth Team (B) and our first girls Youth Team (A). These teams, formed in October this year, comprise 13 boys and 12 girls who are undergoing training every Sunday. The coaches for Team A boys are Arthur Yiu, Pat Fung and Y. F. Ha and the coaches for Team A girls and Team B boys are Eric Chan, Rita Shek, Pat Fung, Y. F. Ha, Ernest Poon and Charlie Cheung. We at last were able to form and enter our first girls league team in this year's triples league led by Tiffany Law, our only female in our original A team. They performed very well as first-time entrants and finished 6th out of 9 teams.

We hope to continue into 2004 with improved successes with the help of all of you, our Association's members.

We thank all those, especially Kelly Yu (of DHL) and Gerry Shirley (of GSPM), who have supported our youth team by their giving freely their finance and/or time to ensure the future of our sport.
